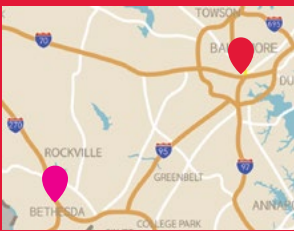

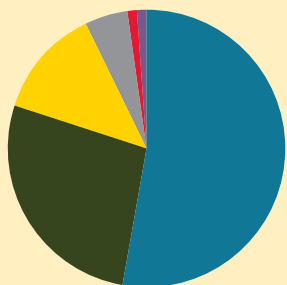

UM SSW has **over 17,000 alumni** practicing in a number of industries.

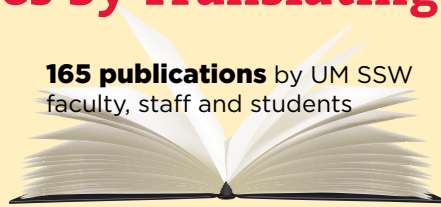
UM SSW graduates have a **94% job acceptance rate*** within 3 months of graduating.

Helping Communities



The Center for Restorative Change (CRC) supports a number of community programs including: Positive Schools Center, Promise Heights, Family Connections, Rise Family Support Center, and B'more for Healthy Babies.

Positive Schools Center supports 30 Baltimore City Public Schools and is the lead agency for 12 community schools.	4,397 community members engaged with Positive School Center Initiatives.	Over 130 Community Partnerships through the Promise Heights Initiative.
875 families positively impacted by Family Connections programming.	B'more for Healthy Babies Program increased the number of moms who gave birth full term by 13%.	Newly opened Family Support Center provides safe and welcoming space where families can access resources.

The Institute for Innovation & Implementation (The Institute) is committed to building research-based, inclusive, culturally responsive, and transformative child-, youth-, and family-serving systems and programs.

29 active grants and contracts worth \$23 million with State, Federal and County Government agencies and private Foundations.	The Institute has trained over 40,000 practitioners in child welfare, children's behavioral health, and other child-serving systems.
3,503 Pyramid Model-related modules completed by early childcare providers, teachers, classroom coaches, and mental health professionals covering topics such as social emotional development, strategies for creating supportive environments, and preventative and targeted intervention strategies for challenging behaviors.
